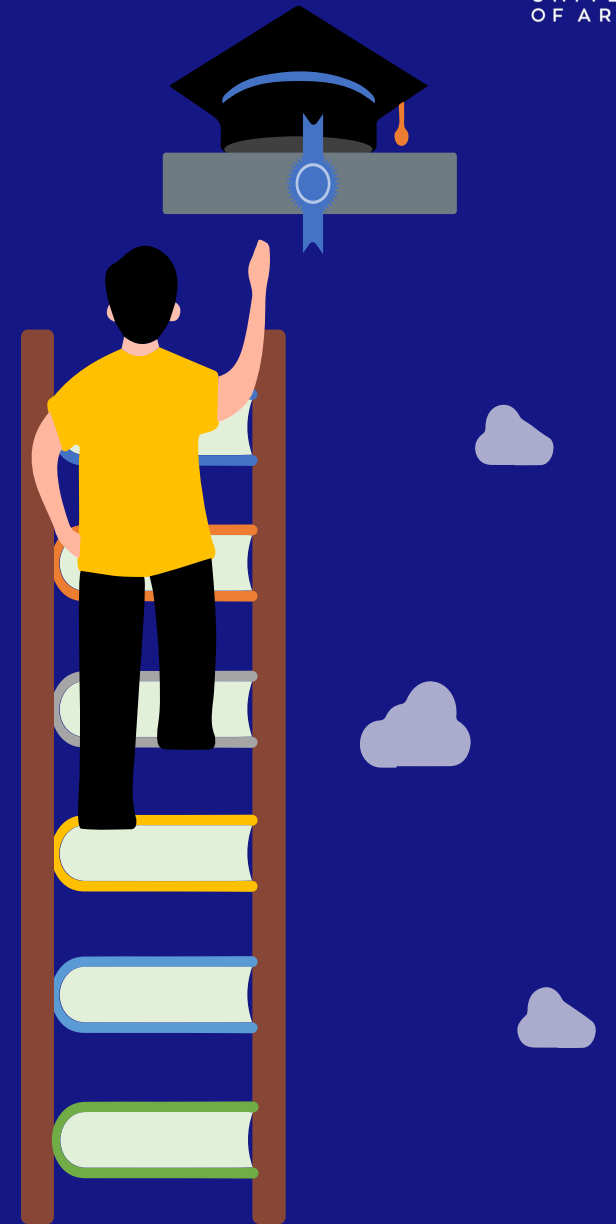

The DP in “Finance” is provided with 240 ECTS academic credits, which are distributed in the following groups:

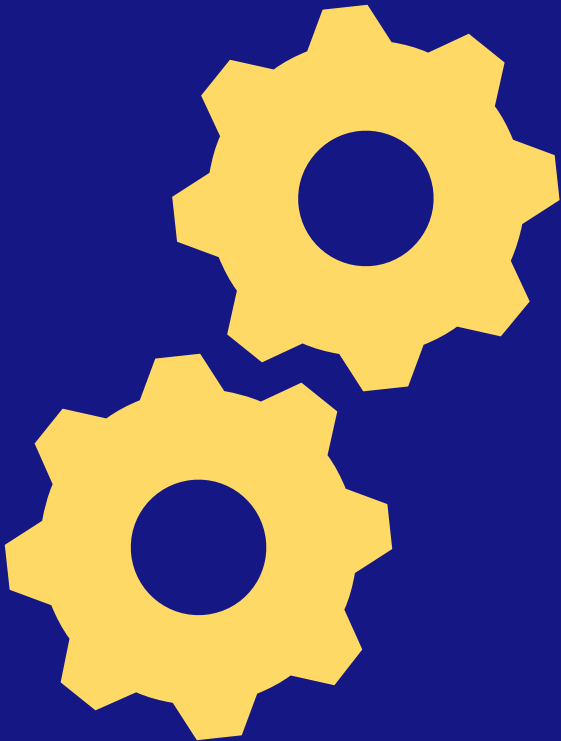
1. General educational structure: 46 ECTS, which includes 2 groups of courses:
