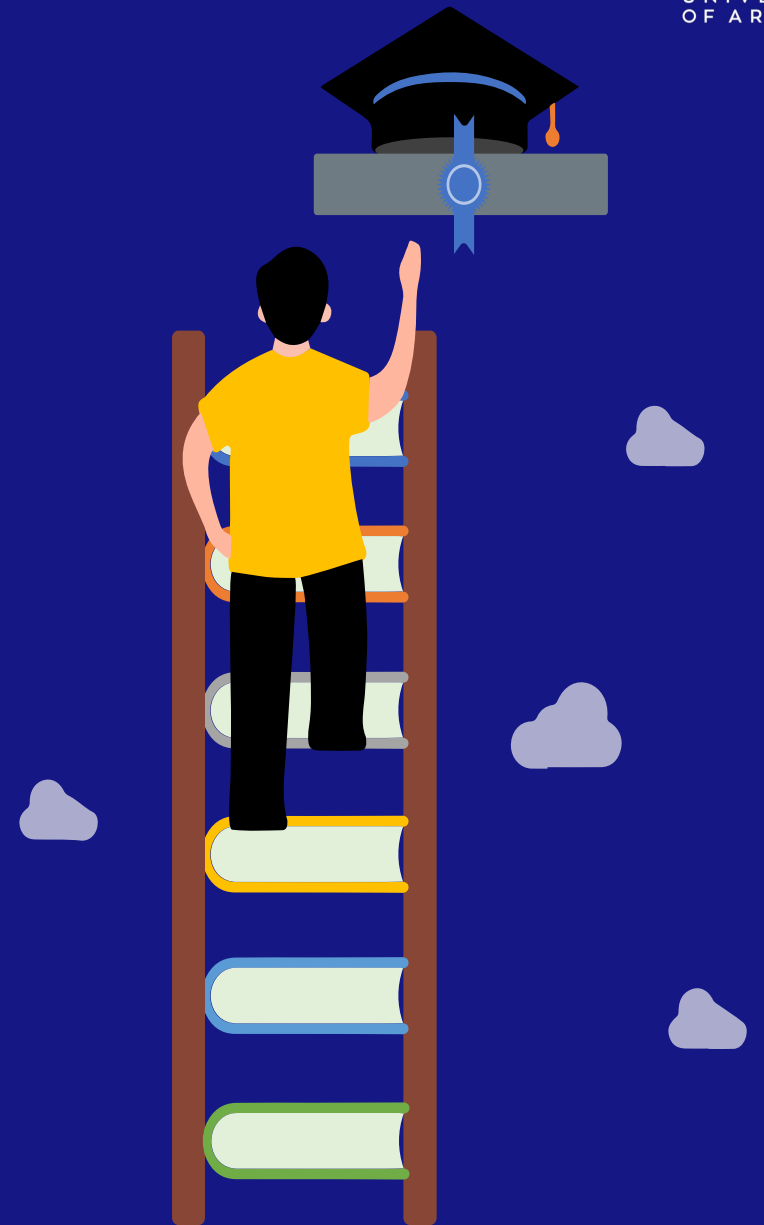




The objectives of the “Law” Master’s DP are the following:
