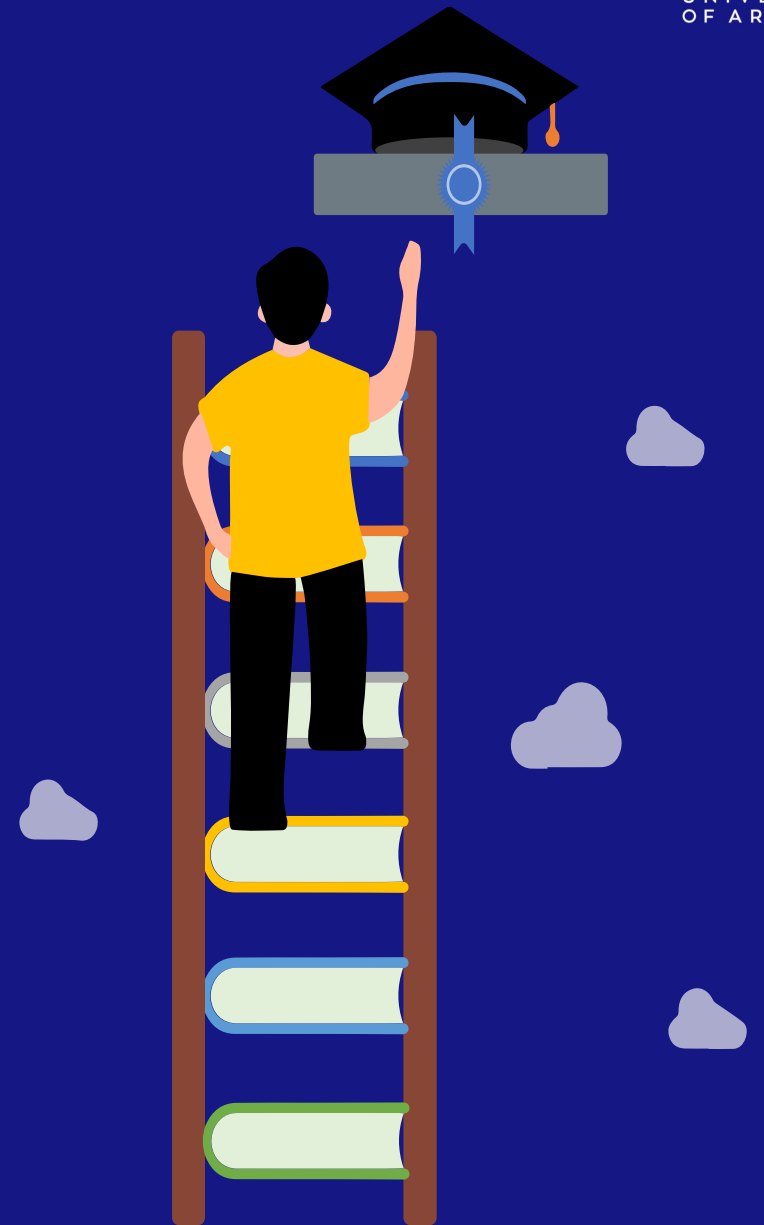




The objectives of the "Psychology" Master's Degree program are:
